

Student Weebly Blog Setup

English, Mr. Eble



We're going to use Weebly as a basis for our class this year. Besides the class page which will contain assignments, resources, readings, and my blog, you'll have your own blog. Here's how to set it up:

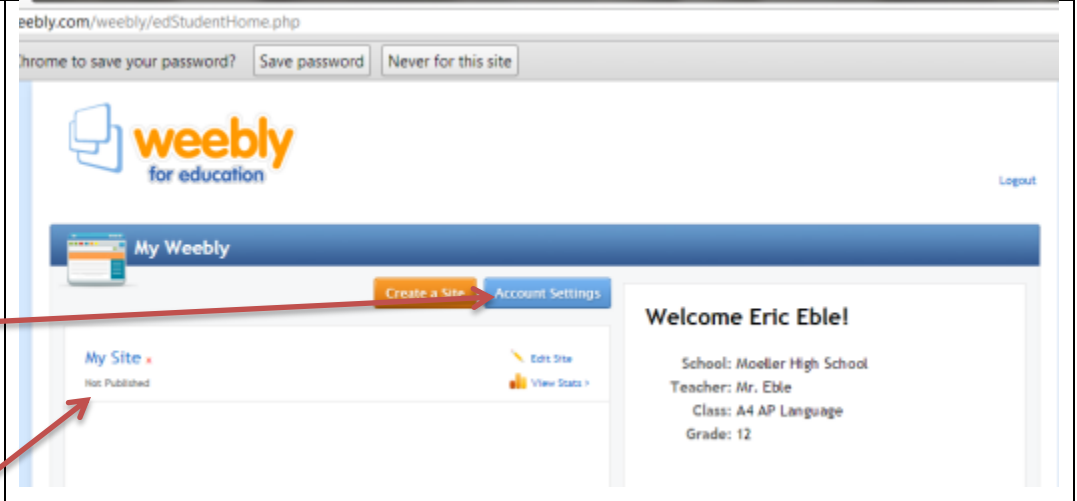
Step 1: Go to <http://students.weebly.com/>. I'll provide your username and password for you in class.

Step 2

After you login, you'll be directed to this page; your name and class period should appear on the right.

I'd suggest saving the password so that you don't forget it. You can also **change your password** by going to "Account Settings" and clicking "Change Your Password."

Click on "My Site," which will bring you to the next step.



Step 3

This dialogue box will appear. I'd like you to use a subdomain of weebly.com. For the name, I'd suggest going with something simple:

- Your first name and last name with a number.
- Your first name and last name, followed by the word "English"

If you'd like to go with a creative name for your blog, please run it by me.

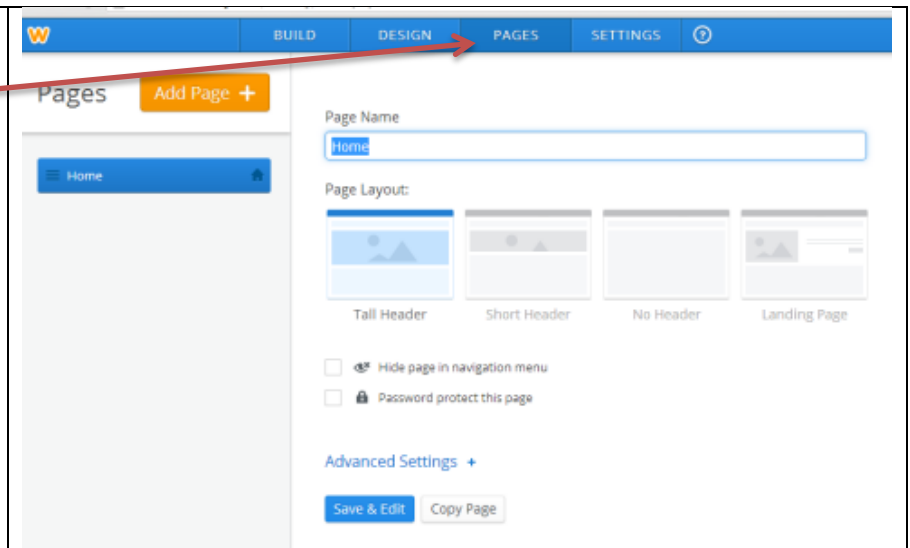
When you finish, click "Continue"



Step 4

You'll be asked if you'd like to plan or build your page. Click on "Build." Then, click on the "Pages" link at the top on the blue bar.

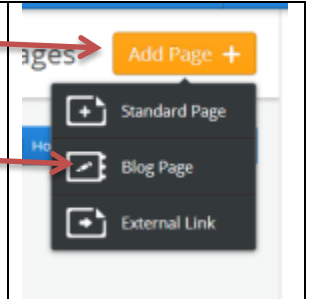
It will bring you to this page.



Step 5

Click the “Add Page” button on the top-left.

A dropdown dialogue box will appear; while I’ll have you add standard pages later, click the “Blog Page” box.



Step 6

You’ll be brought back to the Page editing tool.

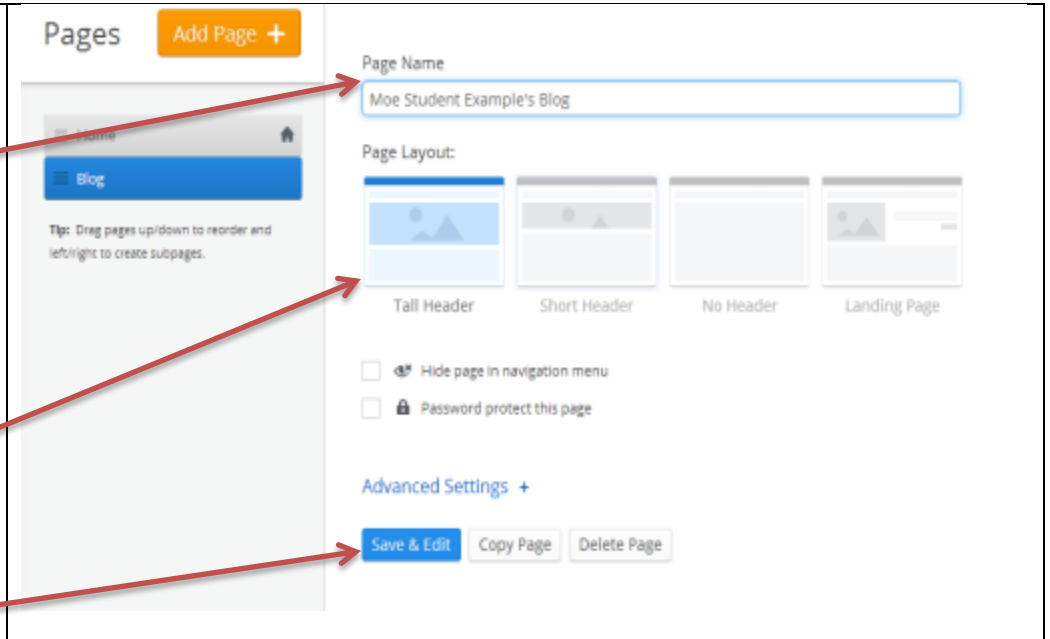
Under “Page Name” for the blog page, write the title under the following formula:

[your first] [last name]’s Blog

Example: Pete Smith’s Blog

Then, you can choose what type of page you’d like under “Page Layout.” I’d suggest a tall header (a header will mean that you can insert pictures)

Click the blue button “Save & Edit”

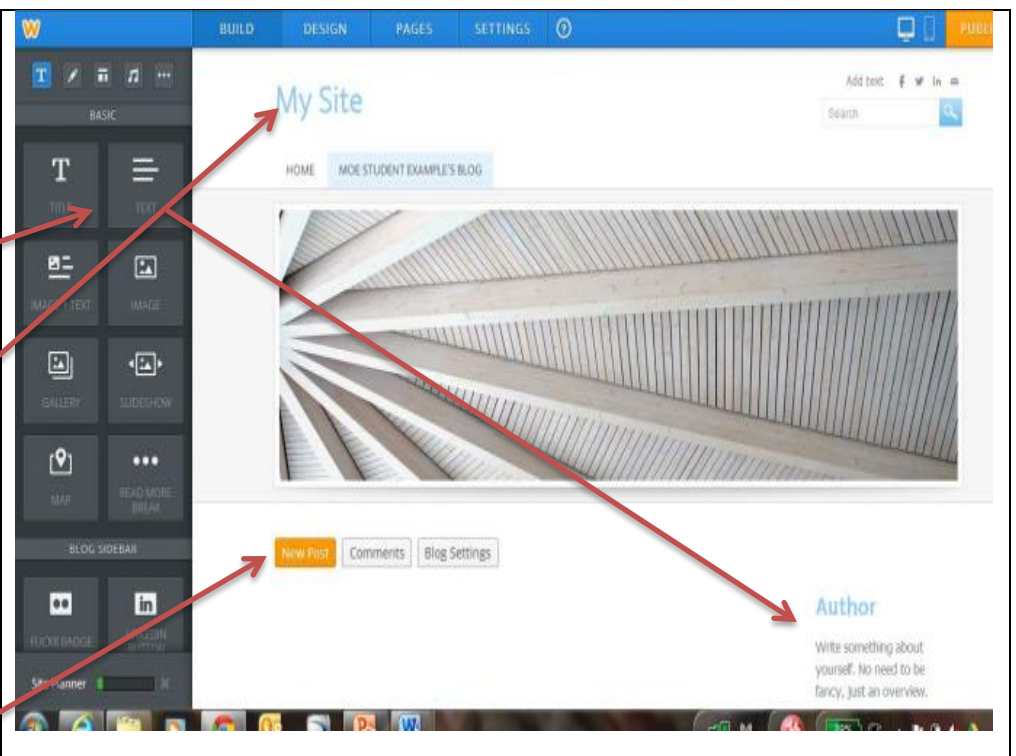


Step 7

You’ll be brought to your actual site page for the blog. Here’s a description of some of the elements:

- The black toolbar on your left allows you to insert a title, text, images, videos, and much more into your blog. You’ll use this whenever you post.
- You can change any of the text on your page simply by clicking on it and typing what you’d like.
- The toolbar below “My Site” will allow you to toggle between your pages; for now, you should only have a “Home” and Blog page.

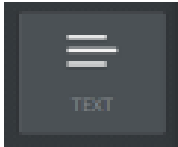
For writing a new blog post, click the orange button, “New Post.”



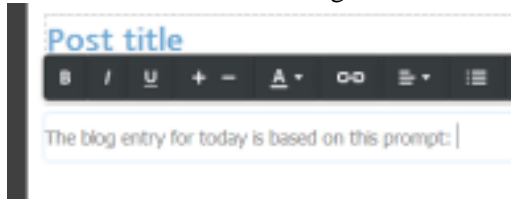
Step 8

You'll be brought to the blog writing dialogue box. For each entry, you should write a title to the blog; I'll let you decide the title.

For basic text entries, click and drag this icon to the *DRAG ELEMENTS HERE* space to the right:



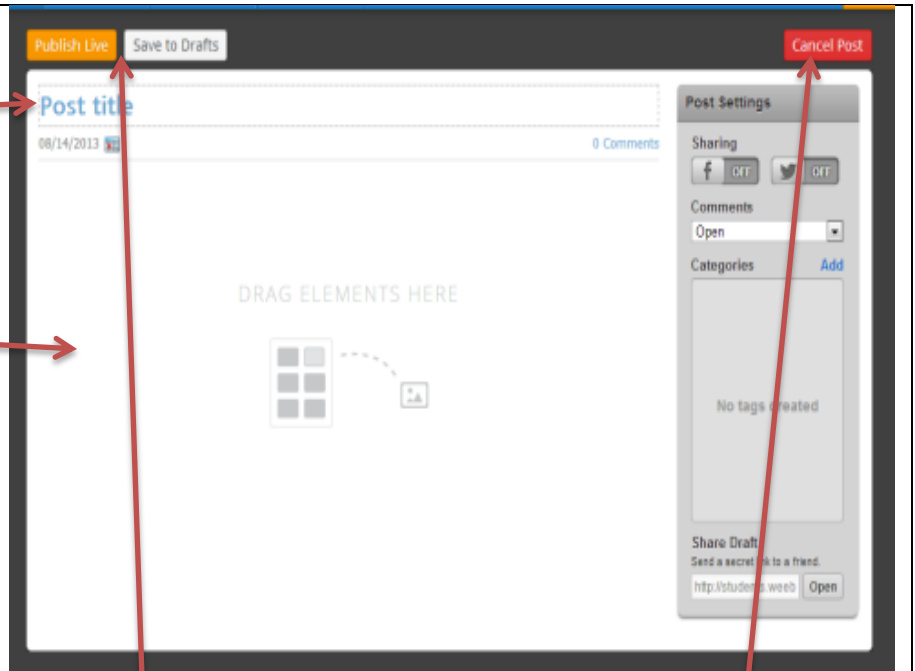
For each entry, I'd like for you to provide a title, as well as the following statement:



After typing this, you should type the blog prompt, followed by your entry.

As you work on your entry, you can click "Save to Drafts" if you're not finished.

When you do finish, click "Publish Live" to post the entry to your blog.



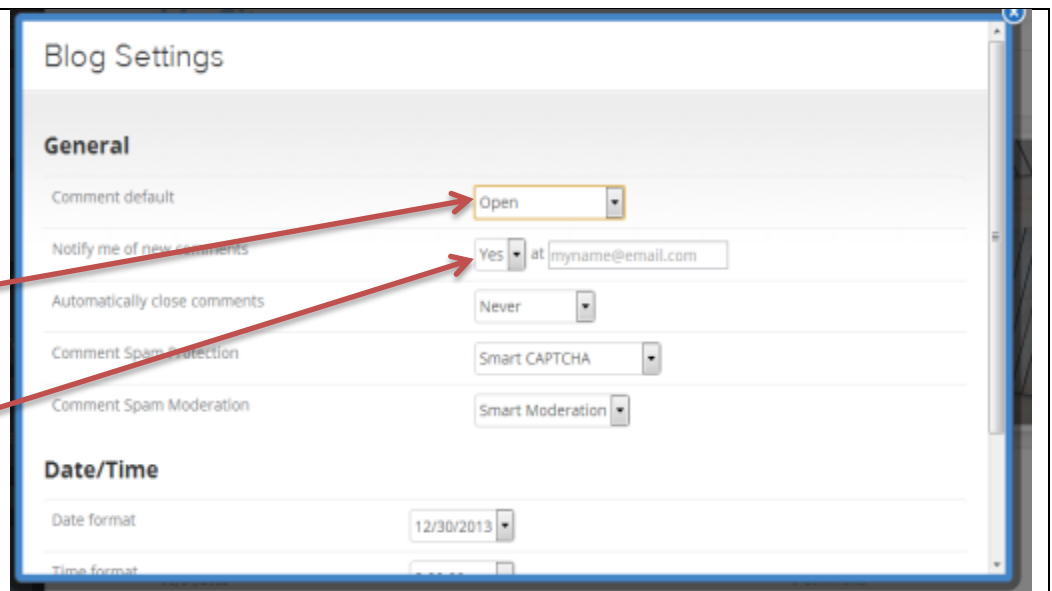
If you'd like to cancel an entry, click "Cancel Post"

Step 9

Finally, when you return to the blog homepage, click *Blog Settings*.

You'll be brought to this page, where I'd like you to make the following changes:

- *Comment Default* should be *Open*
- Notify me of new comments should be *Yes*, with your Moeller email typed into the dialogue box. With this, you'll receive an email any time someone (Mr. Eble or another student) comments on your blog.
- Scroll down to Time Zone; change it to Eastern



All else should stay the same...Now, it's time to blog.
