
Blog Writing: TED and Food Issues

- 1. Visit TED's "Browse Talks" site (https://www.ted.com/talks); type in "Food" to the search box (see the image below)

- 3. Watch this talk; take some notes as you watch it, focusing on these questions:
 - a. What are the intricacies of this food issue? How do they connect to you as a consumer? (of food and in the economy)
 - b. What is effective / ineffective about the speaker's presentation in terms of verbal and nonverbal communication?
- 4. On your blog, please write about this talks. Respond to the questions above in a paragraph or so of writing. Be sure that you name the speaker and the title of the talk.
