For your quarter of work, please respond to the following questions; you do not have to answer all of these in order.

- Explain the work you did this quarter with your mentor group. With what kind of essays / assignments did you help students? With what grade level of student did you work most?
- Evaluate your own work with students. What did you do well? In what areas did you struggle?
- Connect your Writing Center work with your own writing. What did you learn about the writing process as you helped students with their work? About revision? About your own writing for this and other classes?
- What problems / issues did you have with working in the Writing Center? Explain logistical as well as social or

When you have finished your blog, be sure to alert me in a face-to-face discussion or via email. I'll take a look at it and provide a grade based upon

- the extent and details of your self-evaluation and reflection
- connections you make between your WC work and activities / documents from class
- your adherence to standard rules of formatting and grammar
